VING 73rd Army Band Participates in Transfer Day Ceremony Thursday, March 31 on St. Croix

The Adjutant General of the Virgin Islands National Guard, Major General Renaldo Rivera announces that the VING 73rd Army Band will participate in the Transfer Day ceremony taking place on Thursday, March 31 at the Lawaetz Museum in Frederiksted at 10 a.m.

Transfer Day is an official holiday observed in the territory on March 31. It commemorates the 1917 transfer of ownership of the islands from Denmark to America.

The 73rd Army Band was organized and federally recognized September 18, 1974 on St Croix, United States Virgin Islands as the former 666th Army Band under the Commander Warrant Officer 1 Winston Adams.

The U. S. Virgin Islands consists of the four islands of St. Croix, St. Thomas, St. John and Water Island. On 1 Aug 1978, the 666th Army Band unit relocated to the island of St. Thomas.

The 73rd Army Band travels to perform at community events throughout all islands. The band can perform as a Calypso (Reggae) combo, Steel pan ensemble and Concert (marching, jazz and contemporary) band.
