➔ A Soldier was killed in a motorcycle accident March 16 at approximately 0830 local in the vicinity of Wahiawa, Hawaii. The Soldier was operating his 2003 Suzuki GSX-R at a high rate of speed when he lost control of the motorcycle and collided with another vehicle. The Soldier was wearing a helmet but did not have a motorcycle endorsement on his license and had not attended an Army-approved Motorcycle Safety Foundation course. He had purchased the motorcycle only two days prior to the accident.

COST: 1 Soldier Killed

➔ A Soldier was killed in an M1114 HMMWV rollover accident March 19 at approximately 0913 local in Iraq. The Soldier was the gunner of an M1114 HMMWV when the driver attempted to negotiate several craters in the road, lost control of the vehicle, causing it to roll. When the rollover became evident, the vehicle commander gave warning to the occupants. The other three Soldiers in the vehicle were able to safely egress with no injuries.

**COST: 1 Soldier Killed
1 M1114 Damaged**

➔ A Soldier was killed in a maintenance-related accident March 19 at approximately 1600 local in Afghanistan. The Soldier was performing maintenance on the front brake calipers of an Up-Armored M1114 HMMWV sitting on two "bottle-jacks" when the vehicle shifted and fell on him.

COST: 1 Soldier Killed
