- NGB Form 34-1 (Application for Active Guard/Reserve Tour).
- DA 4187 signed by SRFTUS. (Required for On-Board AGR ONLY).
- Applicant must furnish complete medical history regarding Permanent Profile.
- A current height/weight statement from Commander, which includes your height/weight. Also, if you exceed the MAW, you must submit a DA Form 5500-R (Body Fat Content Worksheet).
- Copy of **MEDPROS Individual Medical Readiness Record**
- Certified copy of DA Form 2-1 or DA Form 2, as appropriate.
- Copies of all DD Form 214's and NGB Form 23b (RPAM Statement).
- Last five OER's.
- **Copy of current DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) with last 2 record APFT. Test must be within 12 months.**

IN ACCORDANCE WITH AR 135-18, APPLICANTS REQUESTING INITIAL ENTRY INTO THE AGR PROGRAM, MUST POSSESS THE QUALIFICATIONS PRESCRIBED IN TABLE 2-1, NOT BE DISQUALIFIED UNDER TABLES 2-2 OR 2-3 AND MEET ANY ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS IMPOSED BY THE INARNG.
